RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of New Gloucester.

Additional classrooms in New Gloucester; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$22,000 to be expended by the town of New Gloucester for constructing and equipping 2 additional classrooms to provide space essential for not more than 70 students from the Opportunity Farm in New Gloucester.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Enrollment at Opportunity Farm in New Gloucester will increase. Although New Gloucester has a school district, the schools are overcrowded; therefore, additional space is needed to care for students now residing on the Farm.

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
