AN ACT Relating to Trespass on Airports.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 21, § 15, sub-§ 1, ¶ J, additional. Subsection I of section 15 of chapter 21 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 389 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to be lettered J, to read as follows:

'J. for any person to trespass or operate a motor vehicle upon the landing area of any licensed airport. The provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to authorized persons in the performance of their duties or to persons in the performance of administrative or maintenance duties for the airport.'
