STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Filing of Liens on Buildings and Lots in Unorganized Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 164, § 36, amended. Section 36 of chapter 164 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 3 of chapter 19 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following new sentence:

'If the building, wharf or pier is situated in an unorganized place, the claimant shall file in the office of the register of deeds for the registry district in which such unorganized place is located.'
