STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Pensions of Retired Members of the State Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Pensions increased. The retired members of the state police shall receive, in addition to their present retirement pay, such additional amounts as will equal ½ of the pay per year that is now paid to a member of their respective grades at the time of retirement.

Such moneys shall be appropriated from funds of the state police.

The provisions of this act shall become effective July 1, 1951.
