AN ACT Relative to Poll-Taxes in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 101-A, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 101-A of chapter 14 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 5 of chapter 349 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘It shall be the duty of the state tax assessor through agents as hereinafter provided to procure annually, on or as of April 1, a sworn return enumerating all persons, male or female, 21 years of age and upwards, who are residents of the various unorganized units, government reservations, excepted, of the unorganized territory as defined in section 142 of chapter 37, and he shall give a certificate of residence to all such residents as shall make written application therefor upon the form provided therefor by him.
