AN ACT Relating to Students at Opportunity Farm, New Gloucester.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 40, additional. Chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 40, to read as follows:

'Sec. 40. Status of Opportunity Farm students. Students residing at the Opportunity Farm in New Gloucester shall be classified as nonresident pupils of the town of New Gloucester.'
