STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Powers and Duties of Recorder of the Municipal Court of the City of Biddeford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1899, c. 24, § 1, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 1 of chapter 24 of the private and special laws of 1899 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Whenever the judge of said court shall be absent from the courtroom, shall be sick or engaged in the transaction of eivil business disqualified to act in the transaction of any court business, said recorder shall have and exercise the same powers and perform the same duties which said judge possesses and is authorized to perform in the transaction of civil and criminal business.'
