STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Regulating Shooting Seals in Certain Waters of York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 127, amended. Section 127 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 127. Shooting seals in Casco bay regulated; penalty. No person shall, during the months of June, July and August, destroy seals in the water of Casco bay, and in the water between Branch river, in the town of Kennebunk, and the easterly end of Goose Rock beach, in the town of Kennebunkport, by shooting with rifle or other long-range weapon which might endanger human life, under a penalty of \$50 for each offense.'
