STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the University of Maine for General Purposes of the University.

Additional appropriation for University of Maine. Resolved: That in order to provide funds additional to the regular one mill tax appropriation for general purposes of the university, and for the same purposes there be, and hereby is, appropriated for the University of Maine the sum of \$500,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952, and the sum of \$500,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The mill tax is inadequate for the university to function because of increased costs. The appropriation requested is for minimum needs only and does not provide for expansion of services or for capital expenditure. It may prove insufficient to maintain a balanced budget during the next biennium for the costs of operation and maintenance.
