RESOLVE, in Favor of Stevens Academy in the Town of Blue Hill.

Stevens Academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Stevens Academy, in the town of Blue Hill, the sum of \$1,500 from July 1, 1951 to June 30, 1952 and the sum of \$1,500 from July 1, 1952 to June 30, 1953; said sums to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of said Stevens academy. These amounts are to be taken from the adjustment fund as provided by section 106, subsection II, of chapter 37 of the revised statutes.
