STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of York.

Town of York; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated in favor of the town of York, the sum of \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952, to aid in repairing the Agamenticus road, so called, leading from state aid No. 5 and extending in northwesterly direction to the South Berwick town line.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is an important road connecting 2 towns. It is in poor condition and needs to be repaired.
