IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Hunting of Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 82-A, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 82-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 82-A. Limitation. Only deer with horns not less than 3 inches long may be taken in the odd numbered years and only does may be taken in the even numbered years.'
