AN ACT Relating to Depositing Rubbish on Another's Land.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 124, § 17-A, additional. Chapter 124 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 17-A, to read as follows:

'Depositing Rubbish on Another's Land

Sec. 17-A. Depositing rubbish on another's land; penalty. Whoever reposes rubbish or garbage on land not his own, without the consent of the owner, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$25.'
