STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Road Equipment on Private Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 84, § 31-A, repealed and replaced. Section 31-A of chapter 84 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 433 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby repealed and the following section enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 31-A. Use of highway equipment on private ways. The inhabitants of any town or village corporation at a legal town or village corporation meeting may authorize the selectment or assessors of a village corporation of said town and village corporation to use its highway equipment on private ways within such town or village corporation whenever such selectmen or assessors of a village corporation deem it advisable in the best interests of the town or village corporation for fire and police protection.'
