# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Transporting Children in Open Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 123-A, additional. Chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 123-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 123-A. Transporting children in open trucks prohibited. Whoever transports or permits to be transported children under the age of 18 in or on any open portion of a truck, unless designed or manufactured to carry passengers, shall be punished as provided in section 135.'
