STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Closing the Town of Vinalhaven to Trapping of Muskrats and Mink.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 97, sub-§ I, amended. Subsection I of section 97 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding after the 3rd paragraph thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'No muskrats shall be hunted or trapped in the town of Vinalhaven, including the island of Vinalhaven and the adjoining islands for the years 1951, 1952 and 1953.'
