**RESOLVE, Closing Limestone Stream to Fishing.**

---

**Limestone stream closed to fishing. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to close Limestone stream, otherwise known as Little river, to fishing from the municipal swimming pool dam southerly down stream for a distance of approximately 2,000 feet to a point due north of the Bangor and Aroostook railway passenger station.
