STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for a Fish Screen at Outlet of Highland Lake in the Town of Bridgton.

Outlet of Highland lake; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$500 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen at the outlet of Highland lake in the town of Bridgton in the county of Cumberland; provided, however, that said screen shall not be installed at the outlet of Highland lake until the town of Bridgton shall assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same; and provided further, that the state shall be liable for only $\frac{1}{2}$ the cost of said screen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The old screen is entirely deterioated so that fish are escaping. The screen cannot be repaired.
