AN ACT Relating to Greely Institute.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1913, c. 48, § 2, amended. The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 48 of the private and special laws of 1913 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The board of trustees shall **consist of not less than 7 nor more than 9 members**, and of this number the selectmen of the town of Cumberland, and each of them, during their term of office, shall always be members.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1913, c. 48, amended. Wherever in chapter 48 of the private and special laws of 1913, as amended, the word "Greeley" appears, it shall be changed to be spelled 'Greely'.
