# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

### AN ACT Prohibiting the Sale of Malt Liquor in Glass Containers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 31-A. Chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 31-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 31-A. Sale of malt liquor in glass containers prohibited. No licenses for the sale and distribution of malt liquor in retail stores shall sell and distribute such malt liquor in glass bottles or containers.'
