STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Sunday Sales of Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 57, § 60, sub-§ II, ¶ F, repealed. Paragraph F of subsection II of section 60 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 163 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 57, § 60, sub-§ III, additional. Section 60 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered III, to read as follows:
 - 'III. It shall be the duty of the commission to revoke licenses for making sales on Sunday.'
