HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 336, L. D. 194, Bill "An Act Relating  
to Exemptions from Taxation."

Amend said Bill by striking out the comma after the words  
"United States government" in the 25th line from the end thereof,  
and inserting in place thereof the following underlined words and  
punctuation:

'; and the residence, to the value of \$1,500 of all male and female  
veterans who have served in the armed forces of the United States  
during World War I or any subsequent federally recognized war  
period and who were honorably discharged, or honorably separated  
from such service and retired to the reserve, who shall have reached  
the age of 62 years, or the unremarried widow of such veteran.'
