AN ACT Authorizing Mainente School of Music to Confer Degrees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Mainente School of Music to confer degrees. Mainente School of Music, a corporation located in Lewiston, in the county of Androscoggin, shall have the power and authority to confer the degree of bachelor of music upon all persons who shall have completed satisfactorily at least a 4 years' course in music in said school.
