SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 123, L. D. 212, Bill "An Act Relating to Vacations for Members of the Fire Department of the City of Lewiston."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last paragraph thereof and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

"<u>Sec. 3.</u> Permanent membership. All members of the department designated as permanent members when this chapter was enacted shall continue as such, and the commission may require a period of trial service of not less than 6 months of any applicant for permanent membership before enrolling him upon the list of permanent members. After 1 year of service and less than 5 years of service all those qualified as permanent members shall be entitled to 2 weeks' vacation each year with pay at such time as may be prescribed by the commission. After 5 years of service such permanent members shall be entitled to 3 weeks' vacation each year with pay at such time as may be prescribed by the commission.'"
