STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Vacations for Members of the Fire Department of the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XII, § 3, amended. Section 3 of Article XII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as repealed and replaced by section 14 of chapter 86 of the private and special laws of 1943, is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 3. Permanent membership. All members of the department designated as permanent members when this chapter was enacted shall continue as such, and the commission may require a period of trial service of not less than 6 months of any applicant for permanent membership before enrolling him upon the list of permanent members. After I year of service all those qualified as permanent members shall be entitled to 2 3 weeks' vacation each year with pay at such time as may be prescribed by the commission.'
