IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Mill Tax for University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 117, amended. Section 117 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 117. Mill tax to be assessed to support University of Maine. A tax of + mill 13/4 mills on a dollar shall annually be assessed upon all the property in the state according to the valuation thereof and shall be known as the mill tax for the support of the University of Maine. This tax shall be assessed and collected in the same manner as other state taxes and be paid into the state treasury and designated as the University of Maine fund.'
