AN ACT to Provide Training to Organized Fire Companies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37, § 177-C, additional. Chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 177-C, to read as follows:

'Sec. 177-C. Training for organized fire companies. The state board of education is authorized and empowered to provide training to organized fire companies and to provide mobile training equipment and accessories.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952, and the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953, to carry out the provisions of section 177-C of chapter 37 of the revised statutes of 1944.
