STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Permits to Hunt and Fish for Members of the Armed Services of the United States.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 32, sub-§ XI, additional. Section 32 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new sub-section, to be numbered XI, to read as follows:

'XI. A permit to hunt and fish shall be issued at the resident license fee to a member of the armed forces of the United States of America, stationed at a military post or station within the state, by the clerk of the town adjoining said military post or station. Holders of such permits shall be subject to all the laws of the state and the rules and regulations of the commissioner regulating hunting and fishing; and for violations of said laws or rules and regulations, such permit shall be revoked in the same manner as provided in this chapter for the revocation of hunting and fishing licenses.'
