STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Creating Sutton Island, Hancock County, as a Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 128, amended. Section 128 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto, in alphabetical order, the following:

'Sutton Island: The whole of Sutton island, in the town of Cranberry Isle, Hancock county.'
