**AN ACT Relating to Open Season for Salmon, Trout, Togue and
White Perch.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 36, sub-§ IV, amended. Subsection IV of section 36 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘IV. There shall be an open season for salmon, trout, togue and white perch in brooks and streams from the time the ice is out in the spring season until ~~August~~ **July 15th.**’
