STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season for Salmon, Trout, Togue and White Perch.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 33, § 36, sub-§ IV, amended. Subsection IV of section 36 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 'IV. There shall be an open season for salmon, trout, togue and white perch in brooks and streams from the time the ice is out in the spring season until August July 15th.'
