AN ACT Relating to Licenses to Operate Motor Driven Cycles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 48, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 48 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No license shall be issued to any person under 15 years of age; **provided, however, that a person between 12 and 15 years of age, with the written consent of his parent or guardian, may be issued a license restricted to the operation of motor driven cycles.**'
