**AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Specified Injuries Under the
Workmen's Compensation Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 26, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 405 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

'In addition to compensation for total or partial incapacity or for a specific loss of a member or for permanent impairment of usefulness of any physical function thereof, the employe shall receive compensation for any serious and permanent disfigurement of the face, neck and head, for such number of weeks up to 52 weeks as the commission, upon petition, shall determine to be just; but no such compensation shall be awarded when such disfigurement was caused solely by the loss of, or the use of, an eye or both eyes.'
