SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 440, L. D. 258, Bill "An Act Relating
to Uniforms of Deputy Sheriffs."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of said Bill after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., c. 79, §167, amended. The last sentence of section
167 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and
the following enacted in place thereof:

'Upon approval of the county commissioners, uniforms required by
this section, but not exceeding 2 for any 1 county, shall be fur-
nished by the county.'"
