STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Fabien Boutote, of Fort Kent.

Fabien Boutote; state pension increased. Resolved: That a pension of \$40 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Fabien Boutote, of Fort Kent, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Said pension shall begin July 1, 1951, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

That part of chapter 154 of the resolves of 1947 which provides for a state pension for Fabien Boutote, of Fort Kent, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS The pension which Fabien Boutote is now receiving is inadequate for his needs.
