RESOLVE, in Favor of Corinna Union Academy for Construction of Fireproof Room.

Corinna Union Academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Corinna Union Academy the sum of \$500 from the general fund of the state to assist in the construction of a fireproof room for the heating plant, in the basement of the building.
