STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Closed Season on Partridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 75, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 75 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'There shall be a closed season on pheasants from November 16th to September 30th of the following year, both days inclusive, except that there shall be a closed season on pheasants in the county of Aroostook until September 30, 1952; and no person shall, during the open season, have in possession in any 1 day more than 2 pheasants nor in any 1 open season more than 12 pheasants, nor shall any person at any time buy or sell any pheasants. No person shall have in possession any pheasants taken in closed season.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 33, § 75, amended. Section 75 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding after the 4th paragraph thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'There shall be a closed season on partridge and grouse for 3 years after the effective date of this act.'
