COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 149, L. D. 267, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Recording of Judgments of
Writs of Error."

Amend said bill by adding the following underlined sentence
at the end thereof:

'If the judgment in the criminal case was rendered by
a judge of a municipal court or trial justice as
aforesaid, the certified copy of the record of the
judgment rendered upon the writ of error issued upon
such judgment shall be transmitted to and recorded by
the judge or recorder of such municipal court or trial
justice in the manner aforesaid.'
