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**AN ACT Relating to Recording of Judgments of Writs of Error.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 116, § 12, amended.** Section 12 of chapter 116 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:

‘The clerk of the court recording a judgment rendered upon a writ of error issued upon a judgment in a criminal case, if such judgment in the criminal case be recorded in a court or county other than that in which the judgment on the writ of error is recorded, shall forthwith transmit a certified copy of the record of the judgment rendered upon such writ of error to the clerk of the court in which and for the county where the judgment in the criminal case is recorded. The clerk receiving such copy of the record of a judgment upon a writ of error shall record the same with the record of the judgment in the criminal case upon which the writ of error issued.’
