IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Chelsea.

Town of Chelsea; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$4,892.20 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Chelsea, to reimburse said town for loss of taxes on veterans' property exempted from taxation by law for the years 1949 and 1950.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Due to the fact that the Veterans Administration Center is located at Togus (in Chelsea) many veterans own homes in Chelsea which are not taxable because of state law. As a consequence Chelsea loses each year about \$30,000 of taxable property.
