AN ACT Relating to Equal Pay for Women Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 203-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 203-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 203-A. Equal pay for women teachers. No town or board of education thereof shall discriminate on the basis of sex in the determination of the amounts to be paid or the payments to be made to persons employed as teachers in the public schools. Such adjustments shall be made prior to January 1, 1954.'
