STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Free Hunting, Trapping and Fishing Licenses to Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 32, sub-§ IX, amended. The 2nd sentence of subsection IX of section 32 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following sentence enacted in place thereof:

'For the purpose of this section, an Indian shall be any member on the tribal lists of the Penobscot and Passamaquoddy tribes of Indians.'
