RESOLVE, Opening Portage Lake to Ice Fishing for Certain Fish.

Portage lake opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Portage lake, situated wholly within the town of Portage, county of Aroostook, to ice fishing for rough fish only, namely, smelt, cusk, hornpout, chub, and all other species not classed as game fish, from December 1st until the ice goes out in the spring.
