RESOLVE, Relating to the Taking of Alewives from Walker's Brook.

Taking of alewives from Walker's brook regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue the following rule and regulation:

It shall be unlawful for any person to take, in any manner, more than I peck of alewives per day from the waters of Walker's brook, so called, that run between Walker's pond and the Bagaduce river, in the town of Brooksville; and be it further

Resolves, 1935, c. 7, repealed. Resolved: That chapter 7 of the resolves of 1935 be, and hereby is, repealed.
