STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Duties and Powers of Aroostook County Fire Marshal.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 85, § 72, additional. Chapter 85 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 72, to read as follows:

'Sec. 72. Additional duties and powers. Such marshal shall, within Aroostook county, have all the powers and duties given to inspectors of buildings, fire inspectors and municipal officers by virtue of the provisions of section 19; shall have all the powers and duties given the fire inspector by virtue of section 22; shall have all the powers and duties given to municipal officers, fire inspectors, boards of engineers and chiefs of fire departments by virtue of sections 46, 47, 48 and 49; and shall have the same powers imposed on municipal officers by sections 23 and 24 of chapter 128.'
