STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Permitting the Consolidation of Positions in the City Government of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XVI, § 8-A, additional. Article XVI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 8-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 8-A. Consolidate positions. The board of municipal officers of the city of Lewiston may, when economy or efficiency requires, abolish or consolidate positions held by persons in the employ of the city, excepting those positions occupied by members of the several boards and commissions.'
