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**AN ACT Relating to Parsonsfield Kezar Falls Village Corporation.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1911, c. 216, § 6, amended.** Section 6 of chapter 216 of the private and special laws of 1911 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 6. Corporation may adopt bylaws, etc.** The said corporation, at any legal meeting called for the purpose, may adopt such bylaws, **zoning ordinances** and provisions not inconsistent with the constitution and laws of this state, as they may deem efficient for the better government of the corporation, by a 2/3 vote of those present and voting.'
