STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Parsonsfield Kezar Falls Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1911, c. 216, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 216 of the private and special laws of 1911 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 6. Corporation may adopt bylaws, etc. The said corporation, at any legal meeting called for the purpose, may adopt such bylaws, zoning ordinances and provisions not inconsistent with the constitution and laws of this state, as they may deem efficient for the better government of the corporation, by a 2/3 vote of those present and voting.'
