STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Mill Privileges, Dam Sites and Flowage Rights.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 32, § 11, amended. Section 11 of chapter 32 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 11. Commissioner authorized to sell and grant rights to cut timber; may lease camp sites and mill privileges; preference to Maine citizens. The commissioner, under the direction of the governor and council, shall sell at public or private sale and grant rights to cut timber and grass belonging to the state, and may lease camp sites, mill privileges, dam sites and flowage rights, on lands belonging to the state, on such terms as they direct; also the right to cut timber and grass and lease camp sites, mill privileges, dam sites and flowage rights, and the right to set poles and maintain utility service lines, on public reserved lots in any township or tract of land until the same is incorporated, on such terms as they direct. Preference in such sales or leases shall be given to citizens of this state.'
