STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of the Judge and Recorder of the Town of Lincoln Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1947, c. 85, § 1, amended. The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section I of chapter 85 of the private and special laws of 1947, as amended by section I of chapter 86 of the private and special laws of 1949, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 'His salary shall be \$1,200 \$1,700 a year, beginning January 1, 1951, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Penobscot.'
- Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1947, c. 85, § 1, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 85 of the private and special laws of 1947, as amended by section 2 of chapter 86 of the private and special laws of 1949, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be \$500 \$1,100 a year, beginning January 1, 1951, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Penobscot.'
